## ANGLED HIGHWAY PEG MOUNTING KITS

### **GENERAL**

#### Kit Number

50829-07A, 50830-07A, 50500167, 50500168

#### Models

These kits are designed for installation on Harley-Davidson models equipped with 1-1/4 inch diameter front engine guards.

## **Additional Parts Required**

This kit requires installing a set of male-mount style footpegs.

Proper installation of this kit requires Loctite<sup>®</sup> 243 Threadlocker and Sealant - Blue (P/N 99642-97).

#### NOTE

A service manual for your model motorcycle is available from any Harley-Davidson dealer.

#### Kit Contents

See Figure 2 and Table 1.

#### INSTALLATION

#### **A WARNING**

Position footpegs so rider can operate foot controls without interference. Failure to have full access to foot controls can cause loss of control, which could result in death or serious injury. (00313a)

#### **A** WARNING

Mount the footpegs so they will not strike the ground during cornering. Footpegs striking the ground during cornering can cause loss of control, resulting in death or serious injury. (00458c)

- Determine what height on the engine guard you prefer for the final mounting of the footpeg mounts. Mark location, if desired.
- See Figure 2. Obtain the mounting clamp (1) from kit.
   Position the clamp halves around the engine guard at the
   desired height and install with hinge pin head facing
   upward. The "cogged" face of the clamp should face the
   extension arm.
- Obtain the washer (5), screw (8) and one of the angled arms (11) (long or short depending on kit number) from kit. Using the screw, align and install the angled arm with washer (5) positioned between the clamp "ears".




Figure 1. Installed Footpeg Assembly to Engine Guard

 See Figure 1. Position the angled arm such that footpeg will pivot upward and toward the rear of the motorcycle. Do not tighten completely at this time.

#### NOTE

The footpeg will be a tight fit if the D-spring washer is installed correctly.




Figure 2. Service Parts: Engine Guard Footpeg Mounting Kit

- 5. See Figure 2. Obtain the footpeg (sold separately), D-spring washer (10) and screw (7) from kit. Install the D-spring washer so it is positioned inside the footpeg mount (arm) with the square "D" edge toward the inside of the mount. Hold the washer in place and slide the footpeg into position. Apply two or three drops of Loctite 243 to the screw. Install screw to footpeg and tighten to26 N·m (19 ft-lbs).
- 6. Note the two small tapped holes on the back side of the footpeg mount clevis area. Install the setscrew to the lower of the two holes. The angle of the footpeg is adjusted by running the set screw in and out. Repeat Steps 1 through 6 for the opposite side.

#### **▲ WARNING**

If footpeg mounting location increases motorcycle width, maintain clearance between motorcycle and surrounding persons or objects. Failure to maintain clearance could result in death or serious injury. (00314a)

7. Position the footpeg assemblies so they are at equal heights and symmetrical. Securely tighten each assembly until it cannot be rotated on the engine guard with reasonable foot pressure but do not exceed 55-60 ft-lbs (75-81 Nm) on screw (8).
