## **CUSTOM SHIFTER PEG KIT**

#### **Kit Contents**

#### **INSTALLATION**

- Remove and discard previously installed shifter peg from motorcycle. If needed, use a heat gun to apply heat to the shift lever and shifter peg threads to aid in peg removal.




Figure 1. Service Parts: Shifter Peg Kits

- 2. See Figure 1. Insert the screw through the peg, tread, spacer (if required) into the shift lever. Tighten screw to 15–20 N⋅m (11–15 ft-lbs).
