


Figure 1. Kit Contents

## **INSTALLATION**

## **Remove Existing Equipment**

- Remove existing footpeg and attaching hardware and save for later use.
- 2. Remove chrome swingarm pivot covers, if so equipped.
- 3. Do not remove tool box, if so equipped.

## **Install Passenger Footpeg Support Kit**

NOTE

Make sure the orientation of the support allows the peg to fold up and back.




Figure 2. Install Brackets and Footpeg Mounts

- See Figure 2. Install footpeg brackets (1) and mounts (2) as follows:
  - a. Position footpeg bracket (1) and insert screw (3), removed previously, through support (2) and into footpeg mounting hole in frame.
  - Position semi-circular cutout in bracket extending from side of mount around nut of swingarm pivot bolt or nut.
  - c. Tighten screw (3) to 45-50 ft-lbs (61-67.8 Nm).
- 2. Refer to appropriate I-Sheet for instructions to install the footboards (A) and (B) and pivot pins for your motorcycle.
