


Figure 1. Kit Contents: Quick-Release Sissy Bar Upright Kit

Installation Requirements

 Electrical Contact Lube (Part No. 11300004) or equivalent, is required for proper installation of this kit.

REMOVE




Figure 2. Trim Cover

- 1. See Figure 2. Remove trim covers (2) from body (1).
 - To prevent damage to paint, use plastic prying tool or equivalent.

INSTALL

- 1. See Figure 2. Install backrest docks (3) to body (1).
- 2. Install two screws (4) for each dock. Tighten.

Torque: 13.6 N·m (120 in-lbs)




Figure 3. Release Button Locked Position

- 3. See Figure 3. Align and install upright.
 - Press release button (1) on backrest dock while inserting one leg of upright.
 - Press release button (1) on other backrest dock while inserting opposite leg of upright.
- While holding both legs of upright, firmly press upright further into backrest docks.
 - Release buttons must return to original, extended position to complete installation.

- See Figure 1. If fit of upright in docks is not snug, remove installed O-rings and replace with larger diameter O-rings. Repeat steps 3 and 4.
 - a. A small amount of electrical contact lube can be applied to surface of each O-ring to aid in installation.

PLUG

NOTE

Plugs do not require or use O-rings.

- 1. See Figure 1. When upright (1) is removed, install plugs (5).
- Follow steps 3-5 for installing or removing upright. Refer to INSTALL.

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
