Installation Requirements

LOCTITE 243 MEDIUM STRENGTH THREADLOCKER AND SEALANT (BLUE) (99642-97)

A WARNING

Kit Contents

See Figure 3 and Table 1.

INSTALLATION

- Remove passenger footpeg or passenger footboard assembly (including footboard mount) from vehicle if equipped.




Figure 1. Hardware Removal

- 2. See Figure 1. Remove screw (1) and washer (2) from indicated position on rear fender support.
- Discard screw (1) and save washer (2) for later use. This location is where the upper part of the saddlebag guard will mount.




Figure 2. Rear saddlebag Guard Installed-Right Side

- See Figure 2. Position saddlebag guard top flange (5) with Original Equipment (OE) washer (2) removed earlier between the flange and rear fender support (3).




Figure 3. Service Parts: Softail Rear Saddlebag Guard

- 5. See Figure 3. Install screw (3) and washer (4). Finger tighten only.
- See Figure 2. Position bottom flange (6) of saddlebag guard (4) against vehicle frame (7) at location where passenger footpeg (2) (or passenger footboard bolt) attaches.
- 7. See Figure 3. Determine your model application and follow the applicable installation procedure below:
- Apply two drops of threadlocker to the clean threads of screw before installation.

LOCTITE 243 MEDIUM STRENGTH THREADLOCKER AND SEALANT (BLUE) (99642-97)

On models with passenger footpeg:

- a. Install socket head cap screw (6) through footpeg support
 (A) and guard flange into frame, aligning notch on footpeg support with tab on saddlebag guard.
- b. Secure support bolt. Tighten.

52-64 N·m (38-47 ft-lbs)

- Ensure footpeg support is flat against saddlebag guard flange after tightening.
- d. Install footpeg (B). See service manual.

On models without passenger footpegs:

a. Install button head screw (5) and washer (4) through guard, flange and into frame. Tighten.

57-62 N·m (42-46 ft-lbs)

On models with accessory passenger footboards:

a. Follow installation instructions of footboard mount kit.

- b. Guard flange mounts between footboard mount and frame. Use specified screws included in footboard mount kit.
- c. Ensure footpeg support is flat against saddlebag guard flange after tightening.

- See Figure 1. Torque screw that secures saddlebag guard top flange (see step 4). Tighten.
 - 57-62 N·m (42-46 ft-lbs)
- 9. Repeat steps 1-9 for installing saddlebag guard on opposite side of vehicle.
- 10. Discard remaining original and kit mounting hardware.
