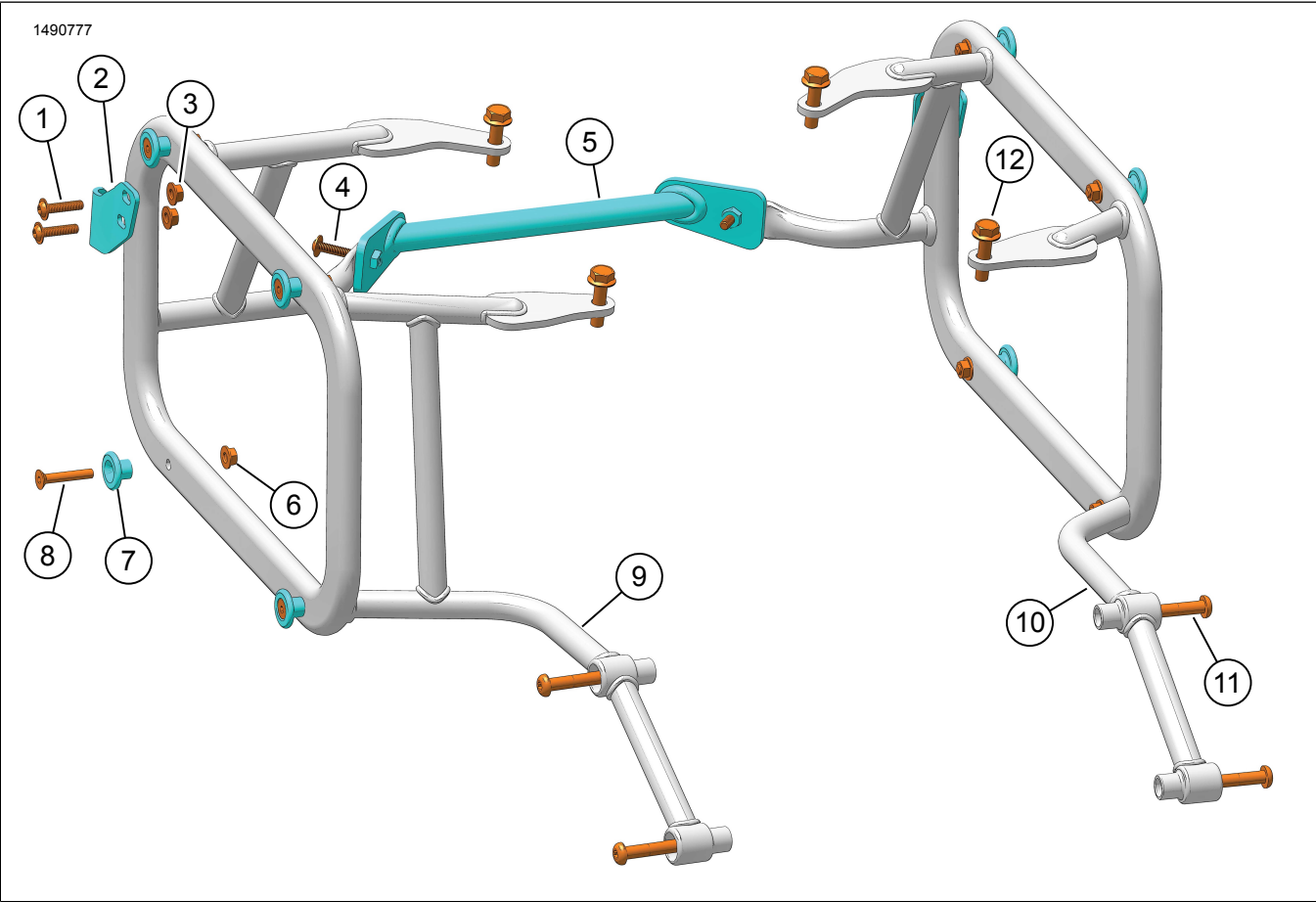


Figure 1. Kit Contents: Side Case Mounting

Installation Requirements

⚠ WARNING

If the procedure is not within your capabilities or you do not have the correct tools, have a Harley-Davidson dealer perform the installation. NOTE

This instruction sheet references service manual information. A service manual for the year and model motorcycle is required for this installation and is available from:

PREPARE

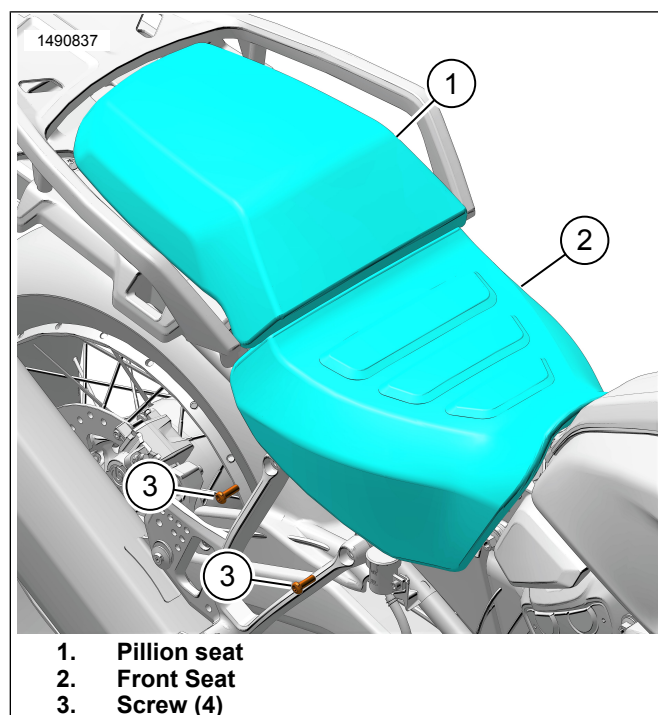


Figure 2. Seat

1. See Figure 2. Remove seat pillion (1) and seat (2). See service manual.
2. Remove screws (3). Support passenger footrests as needed.

INSTALL

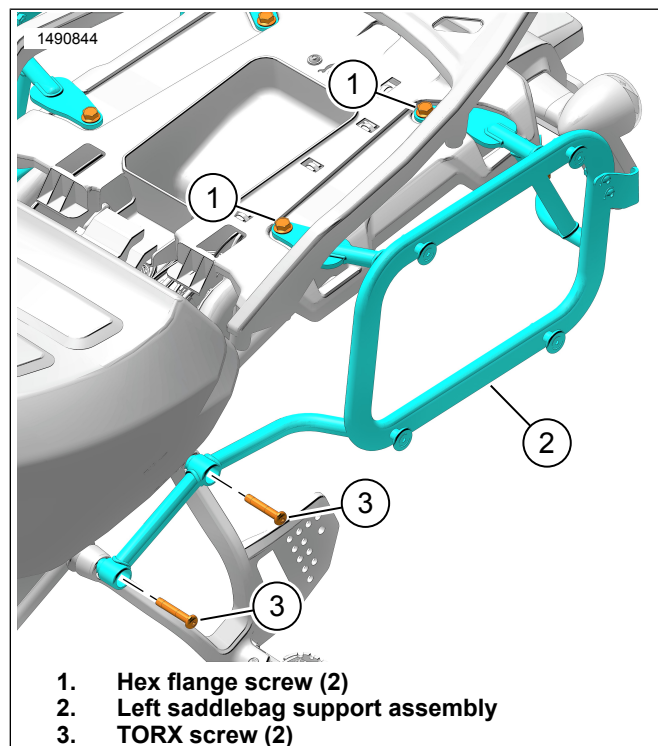


Figure 3. Saddlebag Support Assembly

1. See Figure 3. Position passenger footrest and install left saddlebag support assembly (2).
2. Install screws (1 and 3). Do not tighten completely.
3. Repeat procedure for right side.

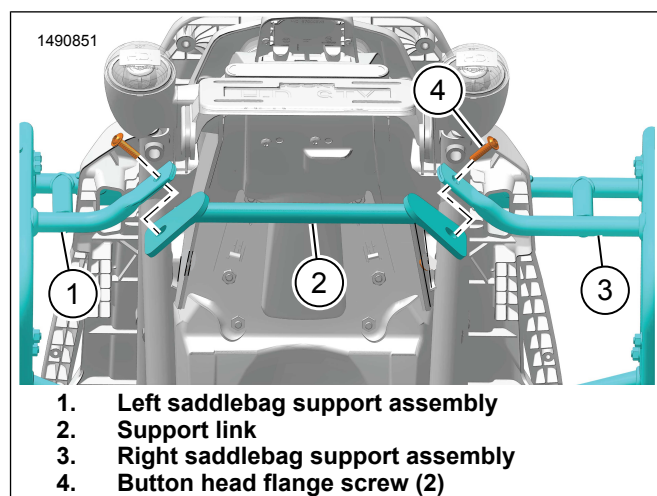


Figure 4. Support Link

4. See Figure 4. Install support link (2).
5. Install screws (4). Do not tighten completely.
6. Make sure all three pieces are positioned and installed properly.
7. See Figure 3. Tighten screws.
 - a. Hex flange screw (1):
Torque: 28.5–32.5 N·m (252–288 **in-lbs**)
 - b. TORX Screw (3):
Torque: 21–25 N·m (186–221 **in-lbs**)

8. See Figure 4. Tighten button head flange screw (4).
Torque: 8–10 N·m (71–89 in-lbs)

LATCH AND DOCKING POINT

NOTE

- Docking points and latch brackets do not come installed.
- If using soft luggage, do not install docking points or latch brackets.
- If using aluminum luggage, install docking points and latch brackets.

Latch

1. See Figure 1. Position latch bracket (2) to saddlebag support assembly (10, 11).
 - a. Make sure latch bracket (2) is installed for the appropriate side.
2. Install screws (1) and nuts (3). Tighten.
Torque: 9.5 N·m (7 ft-lbs)

Docking Point

1. See Figure 1. Position docking point (8) to saddlebag support assembly (10, 11).
2. Install screw (9) and nut (7). Tighten.
Torque: 9.5 N·m (7 ft-lbs)
3. Repeat steps until all docking points have been installed.

COMPLETE

1. See Figure 2. Install seat (2) and seat pillion (1). See service manual.
