## INSTALLATION

## NOTE

- Wear pads and rubber pads must be installed to avoid damage to the Tour-Pak. Periodically check the mast mounting to verify the mast remains in contact with mounting pads.
- Water may enter Tour-Pak when flag mast is installed.

1. See Figure 1. Remove adhesive backing from wear pad (1) and install on area where mast base will touch the painted portion of the Tour-Pak or Saddlebag. If Tour-Pak, attach second wear pad to light bar top taking care to align edge of wear pad to mounting surface of light bar and Tour-Pak.
2. Attach flag mast to Tour-Pak or Saddlebag as shown.
3. See Figure 2. Cut the self-adhesive rubber pad in half. Remove the backing from the rubber pads and install on the inside of the Tour-Pak or Saddlebag on each side of the flag mast (1).
