


Figure 1. Kit Contents: Detachable Conversion Hardware

Installation Requirements

Separate purchase of Docking Hardware kit (Part No. 52300353 or 52300354) is required for installation of this kit.

PREPARE

1. Remove saddlebags. See service manual.

REMOVE




Figure 2. Remove Remote Reservoir Bracket

- 1. See Figure 2. Remove screws (1). Discard.
- Remove Original Equipment (OE) remote reservoir bracket (2).
 - Do not remove or loosen any of the remote reservoir hoses or bolts.
- 3. Repeat steps for opposite side of vehicle.

INSTALL

- Install docking hardware kit (Part No. 52300353 or 52300354). Follow instructions included in that kit.
 - a. Discard mounting washers (Part No. 6302) and screws (Part No. 10200157).
- 2. See Figure 3. Install spacers (5).
- Apply threadlocker to threads of screws (3,4).
 Consumable: LOCTITE 262 HIGH STRENGTH THREADLOCKER AND SEALANT (RED) (94759-99)
- 4. Install OE remote reservoir bracket (2) to outside of fender support and screws (3,4).
- 5. Tightens screws (3,4).
 Torque: 27.1 N·m (20 ft-lbs)
- 6. Repeat steps for opposite side of vehicle.

NOTE

If installing an upright or detachable rack to vehicle, check if there is any contact between rubber sheath on remote reservoir hose and upright bar. If contact exists, place protective tape (4, Figure 1), on both sides of upright bar for protection.



- 1. Install saddlebags. See service manual.
- When saddlebag lids are open, check that no contact exists between reservoir, hoses and lid.

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
