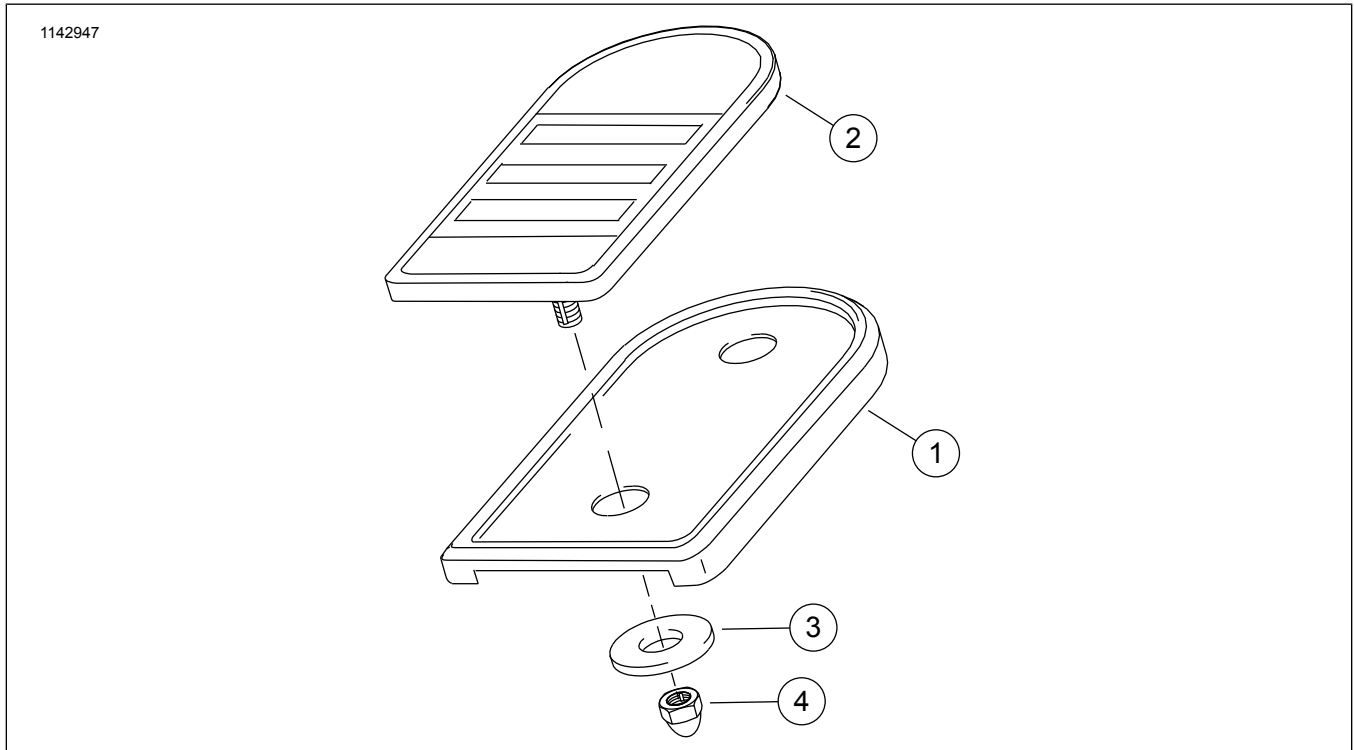


Figure 1. Kit Contents: Chrome Brake Pedal Pad Kit - Large Components

Installation Requirements

▲ WARNING

REMOVE

1. Remove previously installed brake pedal cover (1) from motorcycle.

INSTALL

1. Position and slide **new** brake pedal cover (1) over brake pedal.
2. Align and install **new** brake pedal pad (2) with 5/16-18 stud and insert it through brake pedal cover (1) and brake pedal.
3. Install acorn locknut (4) and washer (3) on stud. Tighten.
Torque: 26 N·m (19 ft-lbs)
