


Figure 1. Kit Contents: Chrome Lower Belt Guard Cover

## **Installation Requirements**

## **PREPARE**

1. Remove left saddlebag. See service manual.

## **REMOVE**




Figure 2. OE Belt Guard

1. See Figure 2. Remove two screws (1) from Original Equipment (OE) belt guard. Save screws (1) for later use.

### **INSTALL**




Figure 3. Install Chrome Cover

- See Figure 3. Install chrome belt guard cover (2) over OE belt guard (1).
  - a. Making sure lower edge of belt guard is inserted into edge clip of cover.
- 2. Install screws (3) loosely.
- Make sure that the chrome belt guard cover does not contact the drive belt, tire or wheel. If necessary, loosen screws (3) and reposition for clearance.

Tighten screws (3).
Torque: 7.3–9.6 N·m (65–85 in-lbs)
